OurPharma, LLC Tax Back Program

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Staff and Administration recommend on behalf of the Mayor's office that the City Council of the City of Fayetteville pass a resolution in support of OurPharma, LLC to participate in the State of Arkansas Tax Back Program. The Arkansas Economic Development Commission seeks local support for the Tax Back Program, and the City Council's action to support this application will result in their approval.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Fayetteville was contacted by Steve Clark, President and CEO and Chung Tan, Chief Economic Development Officer of the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce, seeking endorsement of OurPharma, LLC to participate in the State of Arkansas Tax Back Program of the Consolidated Incentive Act of 2003.

OurPharma is a Fayetteville grown new business that will manufacture and compound pharmaceutical medications. Currently, they are building a new campus at 2512 S City Lake Road in the Fayetteville Commerce District. OurPharma, LLC is making an estimated \$31.2 million investment in the facility, which will consist of 55,720 SF across multiple buildings. Machinery and equipment cost are estimated to be over \$5 million. Initially, OurPharma will create 41 new jobs within the first 2 years, expanding to over 100 new jobs in the future. Average pay is more than \$30 an hour, over two times MIT's estimated living wage for the City of Fayetteville.

DISCUSSION:

OurPharma, LLC meets the Fayetteville First Plan's strategic focus of developing manufacturers and specialized technology companies.

BUDGET/STAFF IMPACT:

We believe the budget impact will be neutral. The job growth and quality wages will spur new sales tax growth from the new employees, but most importantly the development may lead to further expansion in the area supporting OurPharma's needs.

Sales/Use Tax Refund for OurPharma, LLC

OurPharma, LLC has made an application with the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC) to participate in the state's Tax Back (Sales and Use Tax Refund) program. This program allows Arkansas businesses (new or expanding) with a minimum of \$100,000 in new investments to receive a tax back from sales and use tax paid on qualified expenses related to the new development or expansion.

OurPharma, LLC is a home grown new business that will manufacture and/or compound pharmaceutical medications. OurPharma is now working on building a new campus at 2512 S City Lake Road in the Fayetteville Commerce District. This new development project will have:

- a) Two phases, Phase I and II. The investments are estimated at \$31.3M.
- b) New construction of a 22,460 SF compounding facility, a 22,460 SF manufacturing facility, and a 10,800 SF administration building on a green site.
- c) An initial creation of 41 new jobs within the first 2 years and eventually expanding to over a hundred jobs.
- d) Average rate of pay of more than \$30/hr.
- e) Machinery and equipment costs estimated to be over \$5 M



OurPharma meets the criteria for the type of businesses we want in Fayetteville and it is in our targeted sectors recommended in the Fayetteville First Economic Development Strategic Plan. As a locally owned business, OurPharma offers excellent paying jobs while striving to be an innovative manufacturer in the healthcare sector. We expect this company to make a difference in the pharmaceutical arena and to provide affordable solutions to diabetic patients nationally and globally.

We definitely would like to show support for companies such as OurPharma and to encourage future companies to set up their business in Fayetteville that I respectfully request that the City passes a Resolution to support the Tax Back Sales/Use Tax Refund for OurPharma.
