SUBJECT: Addition of City Council Member to Fayetteville Arts Council

RECOMMENDATION:

The appointment of a City Council member to the Fayetteville Arts Council will serve to provide additional support for the City's goals in the promotion of the arts in Fayetteville.

BACKGROUND:

The Fayetteville Arts Council was created by Resolution 60-07 on April 3, 2007 to promote and encourage the appreciation and enhancement of the arts and culture resources of Fayetteville by assisting organizations and individuals who provide leadership to the community on arts related matters.

DISCUSSION:

The Fayetteville Arts Council currently has nine members, all of whom are appointed by the City Council. The proposed amendment would change the composition of the Council to eight members appointed by the City Council and one City Council member appointed by the Mayor. All nine members would have full voting rights on the Arts Council.

One of the current nine members has indicated she cannot serve out her term due to work travel requirements. As such, there will be a vacancy created that can be filled immediately on the effective date of the ordinance. Mayor Jordan has stated that Council Member Sarah Marsh will be appointed to this position if the ordinance is approved.

BUDGET/STAFF IMPACT: There is no budget or staff impact.
