RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of an amendment to the GY2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan to reflect CARES Act supplemental CDBG funding and approval of authority for the Mayor to execute the Amendment upon receipt and for all transactions related to distribution of the additional funds. Staff also recommends approval to submit a budget adjustment recognizing CARES Act supplemental CDBG funding and allocation of funds upon receipt of funds and guidance from HUD.

BACKGROUND:

Fayetteville has been a CDBG Entitlement City for more than 40 years. The CARES Act includes supplemental CDBG funding which requires an amendment to the GY2019 Action Plan.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Fayetteville CARES Act supplemental CDBG funding award is \$436,285.

Approval of the Mayor's authority to execute the Amendment upon receipt will expedite the release of funds. Approval for all transactions related to distribution of funds and to submit a budget adjustment recognizing the funds upon receipt of funds and guidance from HUD will allow for funds to begin assisting the community in a timely manner as the CARES Act intends.
