### **PROGRAM SUMMARY**

In partnership with Northwest Arkansas cities, BikeNWA leads the Slow Streets program to expand safe space for activities outdoors. The goal is to make neighborhood streets safer to walk and bike, creating accessible spaces for activities outdoors. On these streets, residents can exercise, make trips to local businesses, and explore the community.

### **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

Each city has a Slow Streets program plan to meet the needs of that route and community. Slow Streets Crew Members are responsible for the setup and breakdown of the street barricades, signage, and all program materials under the direction of the Event Manager and/or City Lead. This is a labor position and applicants should be prepared to work outdoors in a variety of conditions.

### **TIME REQUIREMENTS**

Must be able to work weekends with few exceptions.

Crew Members should expect 5-8 hours of work on weekends split between setup on Friday, route monitor shifts, and breakdown on Sunday. There is a possibility of additional hours during the week or during other events, as available.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Ability to follow verbal and written directions
- Exhibit good interpersonal skills; collaborate with others and maintain composure when faced with difficult situations and personalities
- Ability to work weekends and occasional weekdays
- Ability to lift and move up to 65lbs

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Setup and breakdown street materials
- Execute city plan as detailed and make notes of any needs or adjustments
- Follow all safety guidelines
- Other duties as required

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Willing to submit to a background check
- Ability to lift and move up to 50lbs

Part-Time associates will receive a flat amount of four (4) hours of holiday pay  
New Year's Day, MLK Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day,

**ODDS & ENDS**

The work environment is often outdoors in variable weather conditions.

While performing the duties of this job, the Special Projects Coordinator is regularly required to stand; reach with hands and arms; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects and/or controls; move/carry files; and sit, walk, talk, and hear. The Special Projects Coordinator must regularly lift and/or move up to 50 lbs. Specific vision abilities required to fulfill the duties of this job include close vision, the ability to perceive color, and the ability to adjust focus in order to handle data collection, analysis, and summary reporting. Computer work will be a small part of workflow.
