I just got a call from Jerry Payton at 903 S. Baldwin Ave about connecting to the city sewer system. I believe the sewer line runs through his front yard, and everyone across the street has access to sewer along with houses to the north and south of him. I believe this item is similar in nature to the one council member Harvey walked on last week, and it sounds like his existing septic system is about to fail and could constitute a health risk. I've spoken with Tim Nyander, and he not only supports this proposed connection, but also the possibility of a walk on item.
