

Striking:

WHEREAS, the City Council should better define its opposition to "sprawl" in Goal 2 of the 2040 Plan; and

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby amends Goal 2 of the City Plan 2040 by deleting its current wording and amending it to read as follows:

"We will discourage environmentally and economically unsustainable development practices by resisting infrastructure expansion around the undeveloped natural edges of Fayetteville."
